ISSUE/SCENARIO

- We are given Sport Premium money from the DFE – schools should use the premium to:
 - Develop or add to the PE and sport activities that the school already offers.
 - Make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years

ACTIONS TAKEN

- We have set up two after school clubs for sport this academic year
- Tuesdays 3:00pm until 4:30pm are for independent travellers
- Thursdays 3:00pm until 4:30pm are for non independent travellers
- Sport Premium and Pupil Premium funding has been used to pay for transport
- Pupils also pay £2.50 per session to contribute further towards transport costs
- Primary students have been invited to attend the after school clubs

IMPACT AND EVIDENCE

- Further opportunities for young people to engage in physical activity
- Embedding positive attitudes towards physical activity and healthy lifestyle choices
- Developing social skills with other young people
- Ex students have volunteered during asc
- Opportunities for Teaching Assistants to develop their skills planning and leading sessions for ASC

NEXT STEPS

- We are currently completing a Satellite Clubs Funding Bid with Greater Sport to make the club sustainable for the next few years
