Sport Premium Action Plan For: Physical Education (Key Stage 2)

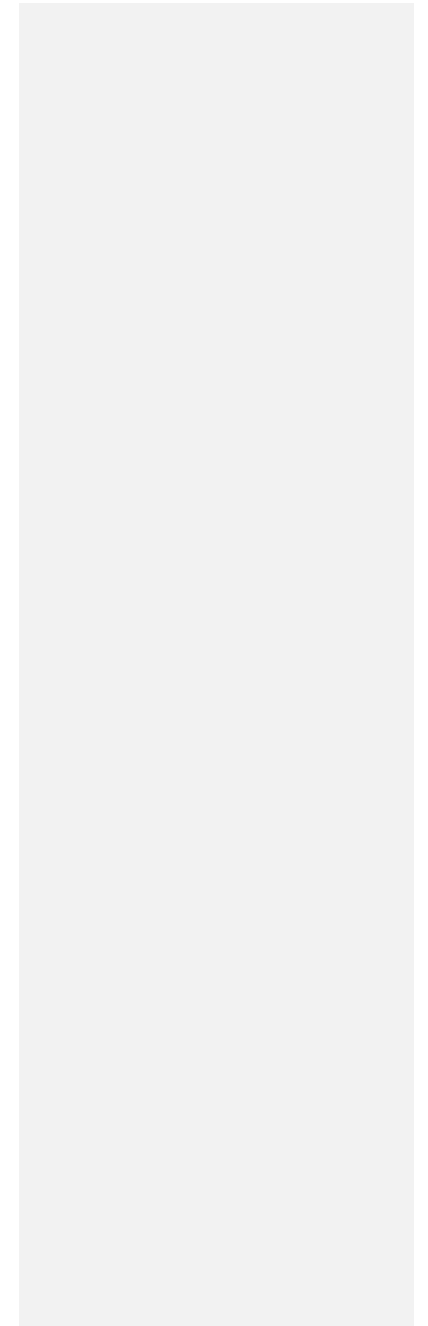

Overview

The Department for Education is providing additional funding of £150 million to primary schools across the UK to improve provision of physical education and sports. They state that schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and School Sport they offer. Schools should use the premium to:

- Develop or add to the PE and sport activities that the school already offers.
- Make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years
