



'WE DID'

- Each half-term a newsletter is sent home to share good news with parents.
- Text messages/emails sent home to inform parents about letters that they can expect from school.
- A Parents' app has been trialled with a sample group of 15 parents.
- Parents have been invited to offer their thoughts and opinions on changes that are happening in school (Homework Policy & new End of Year report format).
- Introduction of post cards home to share positive notes about a child's progress.
- A parents' support group set up and held in school, which is run by parents for parents each half term.
- A Year 7 Coffee Morning was held early in the Autumn term so that parents could meet staff.
- PTA profile raised; currently meet twice each half term and a PTA newsletter is sent out to parents to share their news and invite new parents to attend.
- First Open Book evening, where all parents were invited into school to look through the work their child produced this academic year.
- Bring a Parent to Breakfast - 40 parents in attendance.
- Parents' Afternoon Tea - in excess of 70 parents in attendance.
- Sports Day open to parents for the first time - approximately 50 parents in attendance.
- Raised profile of Sports Awards Evening; also being extended to Achievements Awards to increase the number of parents and pupils able to attend. This has gone from a maximum of 150 attendees last year to 240 this year.
