## Maths & English

We are in the process of transitioning from Functional Skills qualifications to full GCSE pathway in consultation with other Post 16 providers. The FS quals are given less weight now, where they were once seen as a strong equivalent. This will open more opportunities beyond Kings College.

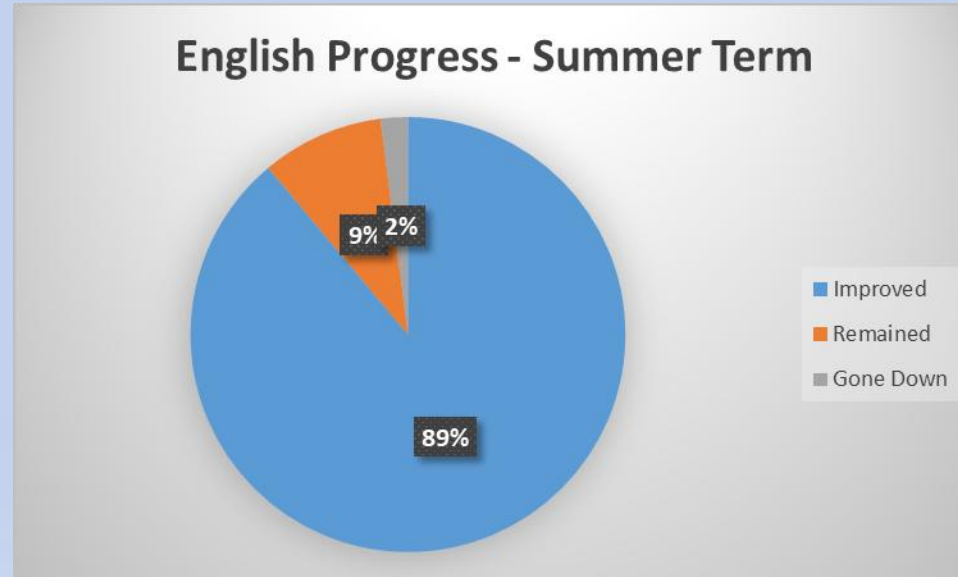
Priority was given to students in Year 13 & 14 moving on to another FE provider in September 2025.

All Kings College students working at Level 1 and above will sit GCSE maths and English in Summer 2026

### English

Summer Term data is based on a distance travelled assessment at the start of the summer term. Autumn is the starting point carried over from the previous academic year.

- Kings College is in a transition year where we are fully moving away from Functional Skills to GCSE. All students working above Entry Level will be entered for Maths GCSE in Summer 2026
- Two students in 'Remained' are working consistently at Level 2 so do not have anywhere to move to
- One student in 'Remained' has been working at Entry 3 consistently but struggling to make the jump to Level 1
- One student -in 'Gone Down' has moved from the Thrive/RARPA pathway to Entry Level so with consistent teaching in 25/26 we expect this to level out.

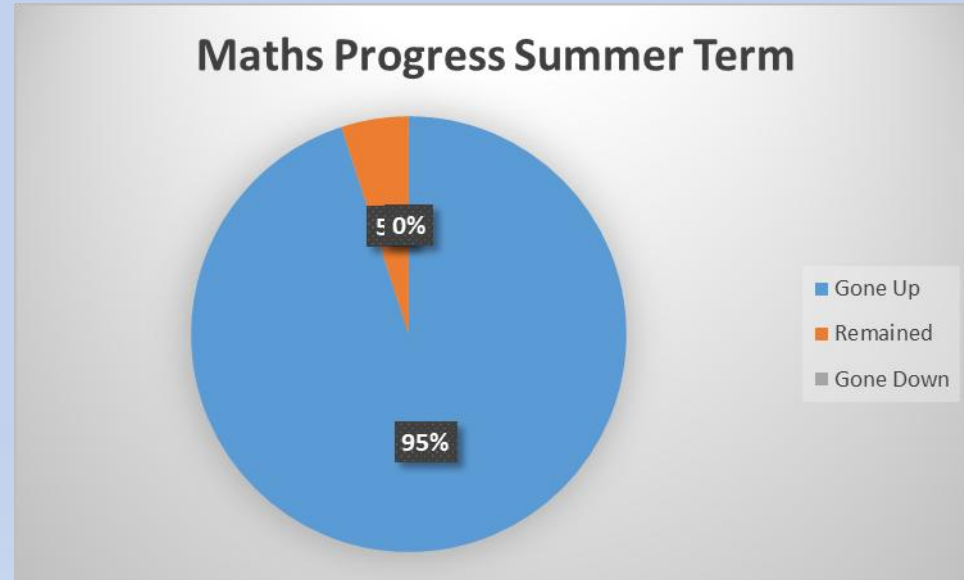

## Maths

Summer Term data is based on a distance travelled assessment at the start of the summer term. Autumn is the starting point carried over from the previous academic year.

- 95% of students have either moved up a level or made above 50% progress at their current level
