Annotation throughout, forming opinions which are relevant to proposed outcomes. Exam plans discussed and completed with staff. Timetable set and materials organised. Pupils to take the time to develop sketchbooks and produce basic design plans for the final outcome. <p>During this term pupils may return to Unit 1 in order to complete/develop any additional pieces of work in support of their submission.</p>	
Summer 1	<p style="text-align: center;">Exam Unit 2</p> <p>A ten hour period completed independently by each candidate following the set exam plans as discussed in the exam preparation time. Additional lessons can be used to complete and develop any outstanding work from Unit 1. Unit 2 developments must be stopped upon completion of the ten hour period and candidates are not permitted to return to Unit 2 exam preparation work.</p>
