Aims

- To foster an **enduring love** of language and literature.
- To support pupils to become **active** readers, writers and communicators.
- Develop an appreciation for the **functional and practical** uses of English.

Remote learning

- The aim of remote learning in English at Oakwood is to match the key learning and skills of each half term and present them in an easily teachable way at home, so that learning isn't lost and pupils do not fall behind where they should be. At Key Stage 4 pupils will do work that prepares them for exams, the same way as if they were at school. We can assess the work produced and gauge how well each pupil is progressing, as these 3 tasks match up with similar tasks we had planned in school.

Task 1

- Go to <https://www.pobble365.com/the-time-traveller/>
- Answer the questions and do the sentence challenges.
- Then create your own story around time. You can use the story opener to prompt you, or create your own story.
- You can also produce a picture of your own around the theme of time travel.

Task 2

- Create a travel blog or diary around the theme of travel
- Think of a place you would like to visit - real or imaginary.
- Write your piece about what you did, where you went, what you saw, who you met and how you felt. It could be good or bad.
- Remember to write in first person and include details like date, time, place, names etc.

Task 3

- Design an advert for a clock/watch
- You could research all of the different types of watches and clocks there are - some are very expensive; some have themes.
- Create a poster that has an image of your clock/watch
- It also needs to have persuasive language on it that makes people want to buy it
- Think carefully about colours
- Include price and facts about it
