Aims

- To foster an **enduring love** of language and literature.
- To support pupils to become **active** readers, writers and communicators.
- Develop an appreciation for the **functional and practical** uses of English.

Remote Learning

- The aim of remote learning in English at Oakwood is to match the key learning and skills of each half term and present them in an easily teachable way at home, so that learning isn't lost and pupils do not fall behind where they should be. At Key Stage 4 pupils will do work that prepares them for exams, the same way as if they were at school. We can assess the work produced and gauge how well each pupil is progressing, as these 3 tasks match up with similar tasks we had planned in school.

Task 1

- Do the exercises: picture, sentence challenge, questions
- Then write a story based on the idea of animals taking over
- Either use the story prompt or create a story of your own

Task 2

- Write a newspaper article about animals taking over
- Think about which animals have taken over and where
- Create a newspaper front page with a headline, picture and an interview with eye-witnesses.
- Try to use emotive language

Task 3

- Write a persuasive speech asking people not to eat meat (to be vegetarian)
- Think of all the reasons you can why someone should stop eating meat
- Use persuasive techniques - rhetorical questions, repetition, emotive language
