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LEARNING TASK 1 - GARDENING



1. Wildlife in the garden:

Find out which plants attract butterflies and design a butterfly - friendly flower border for the garden. Draw your design and label the plants.

LEARNING TASK 2 - GARDENING



- ▶ Identify small animals, including mammals, reptiles and insects that should be encouraged into the garden. Make a display of pictures of these animals and explain why they are beneficial.

LEARNING TASK 3 - GARDENING



- ▶ Carry out a survey of the birds in your garden. Record the different species and how often they visit. Display your data and suggest ways that you could encourage more birds to your garden.

LEARNING TASK 4 - GARDENING

- Find a recipe to make bird food (eg a fat ball, a seed cake) and make one for your garden area. Keep note of what birds feed from it.
