Push and Pull Factors

Push and Pull factors are things that might make someone move **TO** or **FROM** a location.

For example, lower wages where you live might **PUSH** you to move away. Cheaper housing in another city might **PULL** you towards that city.

Create a list of as many Push and Pull factors as you can think of, in a table. An example is below.

Push Factors	Pull Factors
A Push Factor is something that PUSHES you away from an area.	A Pull Factor is something that PULLS you towards a new area.
Low Wages	Higher Wages
High Crime	Cheaper Housing
