Basic Learning in Humanities

In Humanities, students get the opportunity to discover and explore a world outside of their own experiences. Humanities aims to gift children and young people with transferrable skills and knowledge which will not only help them academically, but in life. We learn from the mistakes of the past, and look at how the world is changing around us because of it.

Home Learning Task 1 – Year 7

1

Ask students to look closely at the pictures. Work with them to pick out information about Stone Age people. For example, "What weapons are they using?" "What are they made out of?" "Why do you think they're made out of that?"

2

Using the information you get, ask the students to write a diary entry as if they WERE a Stone Age person. Think about what they might eat, how they would cook, what they might do in their day. (Stone age were mainly hunter/gatherers, so a lot of time would be spent searching for food!)

When writing the diary, please encourage the students to include the following:

- The date / Start with "Dear Diary"
- Write in first person ("I" went... etc)
- The events of the day, and how it made them feel.
