- ▶ Research and write down what a 'chord' is in music and give 3 examples.

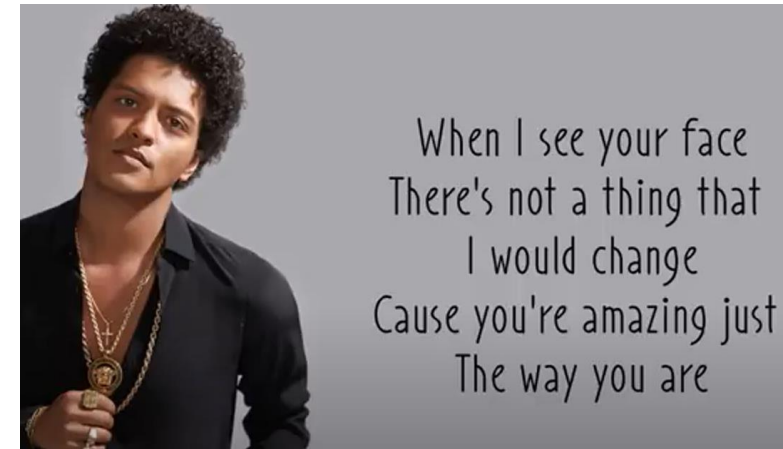


Why?
