The Wider World (complete a study on another country looking at culture, special occasions, customs places of interest)


Health and Survival (balanced diet, personal hygiene, dealing with basic first aid - cuts/burns/nosebleeds)


'Hands Only' CPR (A recognized First Aid course. Introducing them to primary and secondary care when dealing with a casualty)

Who is the option suitable for?


- The ASDAN option is suitable for any pupils who struggle accessing GCSE's.

Students are encouraged to look after and be responsible for



















