Drama can develop many other practical skills such as teamwork, confidence, and resilience. It can also help you understand and manage emotions. This qualification can help you with further study and prepare you for the world of work

Who is the option suitable for?

- Arts Award Explore is aimed at creative pupils who enjoy expressing themselves through speech and movement.
- There is lots of teamwork involved in performing arts.

Course Information

- Arts Award Explore is an Entry Level 3 Qualification.
- Arts Award Explore enables learners to develop a basic understanding of a range of art forms, artists and arts organisations, to commit to taking part in arts activities and to demonstrate a basic understanding of communication.
- The qualification is divided into four sections: Take Part, Explore, Create, and Share.

Course Information

- Pupils are assessed in three core areas: Knowledge and Understanding, Creativity, and Communication.
- Learners create a personal arts log (portfolio) containing evidence of their experiences.
- Photography and video recordings will form a large part of pupil portfolios.
- However, there will still be some writing involved!
